

# Second Beach Family Campground

## Rules, Regulations & Operating Policy 2007

The operating goal of the Campground is to provide a peaceful, beach-camp atmosphere for those who love the ocean. Recreational facilities include shuffleboard, basketball, and volleyball. Unlike some resort camps, we emphasize evenings of moderate sociability with posted quiet hours. An active off-site nightlife is available via a ten-minute drive to Newport or Middletown.

### Occupancy Policy

Camping entitlement includes the following:

1. Family use of the site to which you are assigned and use of the common camp areas.
  - A. *Long term* (signed lease agreement) residents are defined as registered campers, parents, children, & grandchildren. All other visitors are subject to an overnight visitors' fee of \$2.00 per person per day.
  - B. *Short-term* (all sites not on lease agreement) rates are based on 4 people (\$2.00 per night per additional person.) All visitors are subject to daily parking fees (\$10 or \$20) when space is available.
2. Access to Second Beach, also known as Sachuest Beach, exclusive of the parking fee.
3. Water, electricity and sewage hookups at each site.
4. Rest room facilities, which include hot water showers.
5. All campers (less than seasonal or monthly) are subject to daily parking fees for excess of one vehicle. These rates are based on the parking fees of Sachuest Beach:

Saturday, Sunday, & Holidays	\$20.00 per day
Monday through Friday	\$10.00 per day
6. If parking spaces are not being used, the Managers may rent them to Sachuest Beach visitors.
7. The following recreational vehicle (RV) site rental policies apply:

Priority will be given to long term rentals. When possible, preference will be given to past camp residents subject to site availability and compatibility with RV size.

Rental Periods of less than four- (4) months are secondary to Seasonal Rentals.

### Camp Administration:

1. Please check in and out with the campground office at the beginning and end of your stay.
2. Check in time is 2:00 PM. Campers must check out by 11:00 am.

3. Speed Limit: 5 mph (motor vehicles and bicycles).
4. Camp tenants and visitors must stop and be identified at all times when entering the campground by vehicle during office hours, which are 9:00 am to 8:00 PM.
5. The bulletin board at the office should be reviewed daily for messages and campground information.
6. Please notify the office of service/facility problems as soon as they occur.
7. Campers use the recreational areas and equipment at their own risk.
8. Trailer size is limited (see Management). Only a limited number of sites can accommodate trailers in excess of 30 feet and with slideouts.
9. No tents are permitted. However, pop-up tent trailers with wheels are permitted to park.
10. Main Gate will be closed at 8:00 PM Monday thru Sunday, and 9:00 PM Friday and Saturday.

### **Campsite Rules:**

1. One RV and one car are permitted at each site. Boats and additional cars must be parked in reserved parking areas arranged through the office. Please consult with the office before erecting a free standing screen room.
2. Campers must park in their own campsite or assigned parking area only.
3. An RV will not be occupied by anyone other than the registered tenant unless prior arrangements have been made with the office.
4. Patio platforms are permitted within the perimeter of the assigned site.
5. Please walk and play only in open or designated public areas. No littering is allowed: please collect all refuse in plastic bags provided by the camp office. Place filled bags in the garbage dumpster located at the entrance to the campground. Please break down all cardboard items. Recycle bins are located in the same area.
6. No open fires are allowed in the campsites. A central fire pit is provided. Charcoal/gas grills are permitted.
7. No Firearms are allowed in the campground, unless you can provide information that proves that the firearm is job related.
8. No Fireworks are allowed in the campground or beaches.
9. Blankets, towels, & swimsuits (no laundry) must be hung in designated areas, not in campsites or on fences.
10. No maintenance or washing of vehicles is allowed.
11. No pets are allowed.
12. No swapping of parking spaces is allowed without prior approval by the office.
13. Quiet time is 10:00 PM to 7:00 am weekdays, 11:00 PM to 7:00 am weekends. No loud noises or unruly behavior are permitted at any time. No basketball playing after 9 PM on weekdays and 10 PM on weekends.
14. Campers are responsible for their visitors' compliance with camp rules.
15. The main gate is normally closed from 8:00 PM to 7:00 am on weekdays and 9:00 PM to 7:00 am on weekends.

16. Please respect your neighbors – pick a convenient time to discharge black water tanks.

**Visitors :**

1. Visiting hours are between 8:00 am and 11:00 PM.
2. Visitors are subject to parking and overnight fees.

**Restrooms and Showers :** (locked at all times)

1. Camp residents are issued restroom keys with a \$5.00 refundable deposit per key.
2. Cleaning times are posted on restroom doors (10:30 AM- 11:30 AM).
3. Please help us keep a clean facility. Kindly rinse off sand before entering. Do not leave an unsightly restroom for the next person.
4. No bare feet are allowed in restrooms.
5. No smoking is allowed in restrooms.
6. Sewer cap deposit: a deposit of \$5.00 is required for the sewer cap. At the end of your stay the cap must be returned for reimbursement.

**Children:**

1. Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.
2. Please familiarize all children with the campground and restroom rules.
3. Children under the age of nine (9) years old must be accompanied by an adult when using the restrooms and showers.
4. The use of Whiffle and Nerf balls is permitted on the “Green” except during quiet hours. Due to the risk of damage to RVs, the use of soccer balls and other types of balls is not permitted.

*Violation of any rules, regulations or guest policies may result in the immediate eviction of the entire party from the campground, without refund.*

***All additions, deletions, and interpretations of policies, rules and regulations will be at the discretion of the “on-site” campground managers.***
